### **CLASS OBSERVATION**

Only one parent/guardian should be accompanying dancers ages 7 & under.

- We have found that our younger dancers succeed more in class without the hallway distractions.
- If you think your dancer will come into the studio on their own, we strongly encourage that independence!
- Please only bring siblings if absolutely necessary.

#### **BREAKS BETWEEN CLASSES**

Dancers may stay in the studio for breaks that are 45 minutes or shorter.

- If watching an electronic device, or listening to music, bring headphones.
- If having a snack or quick dinner, please be respectful of the studio and clean up after yourself.
- If dancers/parents cannot abide by the above, they will not be permitted to stay in the studio during breaks.

#### **BATHROOM BEFORE CLASS**

#### **ONLY WATER IN THE STUDIO**



ONLY WATER IS PERMITTED IN THE DANCE ROOMS. NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGES.

#### **CUBBIES**



DANCERS MAY UTILIZE THE CUBBIES FOR THEIR SHOES, CLOTHING AND JACKETS.

DANCERS MAY BRING THEIR BAGS INTO THE DANCE STUDIO AND HANG THEM UP ON A HOOK.

### SIBLINGS



IF YOU NEED TO BRING SIBLINGS WITH YOU, PLEASE KEEP AN EYE ON THEM. THEY SHOULD BE QUIET AND NOT RUNNING AROUND, OR DISRUPTING CLASSES.

CLIMBING/SITTING ON THE CUBBIES IS NOT PERMITTED AND IS A SAFETY CONCERN.
